We have implemented a one-way system on entering the centre to help maintain social distancing. We ask that you follow the signage on entering, and inside the centre.



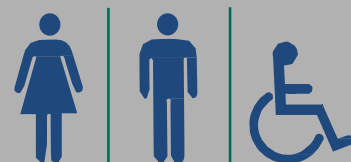
Has the cleaning of the centre been increased?
